

▶ **Playing *High Roller***

(*Math Masters*, p. 344)



This game can be played with 2 players or in small groups. Each group should have a few copies of the *High Roller* recording sheet.

Directions

1. Players take turns. The first player rolls 2 dice and records the roll in the first two squares. He or she keeps the die with the larger number (the High Roller) and crosses out the smaller number on the recording sheet.
2. The first player rolls the other (smaller) die again and records the roll. He or she counts on from the number rolled on the first die to get the sum of the two dice.
3. The first player records the sum on the line.
4. The second player repeats this process.
5. Players continue to take turns as time allows.
